The Canadian Vehicle Manufacturers' Association (CVMA) was founded in 1926 and represents Canada's largest manufacturers of light and heavy duty motor vehicles including DaimlerChrysler Canada Inc., Ford Motor Company of Canada, Limited, General Motors of Canada Limited and International Truck and Engine Corporation Canada. Our members account for 75% of all vehicle production and 57% of all vehicle sales in Canada. Our members directly support over 100,000 Canadians through their assembly, office and retail operations plus an additional 50,000 Canadian retirees.

In 2005 our members sold over 59% of all new passenger cars in Canada and 25% of light duty trucks.
