

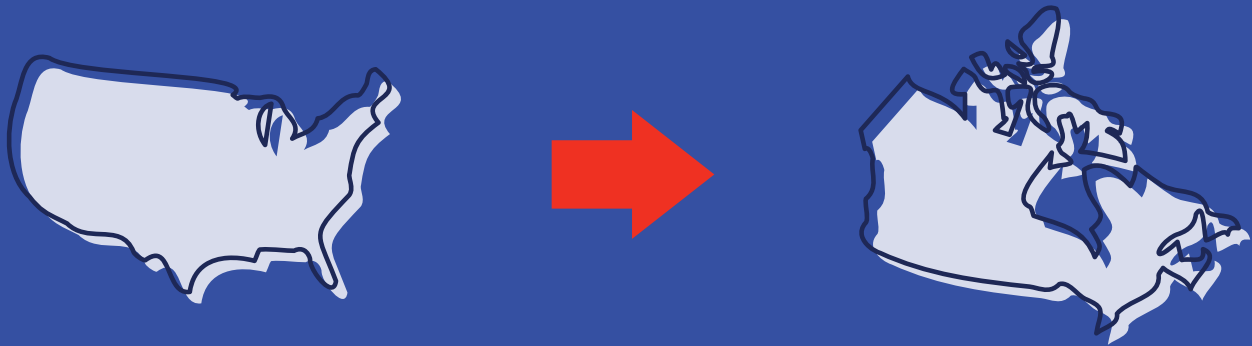

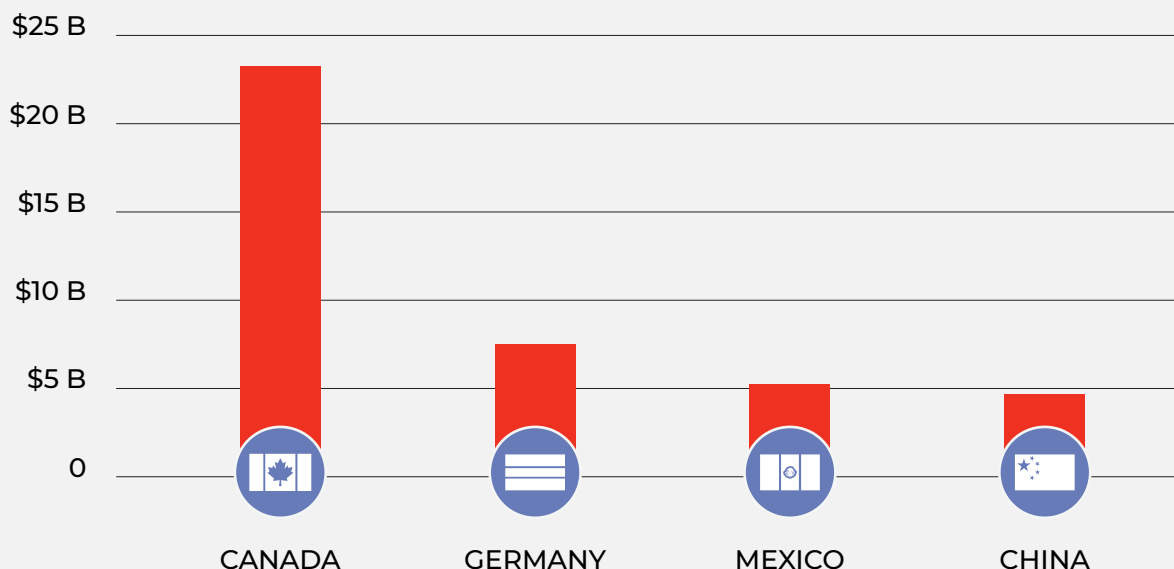
ABOUT THE CANADA-US AUTO TRADE RELATIONSHIP

The Canada-US bilateral automotive trade relationship is balanced: US surplus in parts and vehicles of \$900 mn USD in 2024.



Canada is the largest US export market for passenger vehicles and light trucks: US exports of \$23 bn USD in 2024 – more than US exports to Germany, Mexico and China combined.

Since 2020, automakers and suppliers have made about USD \$288 billion in new North American investments.

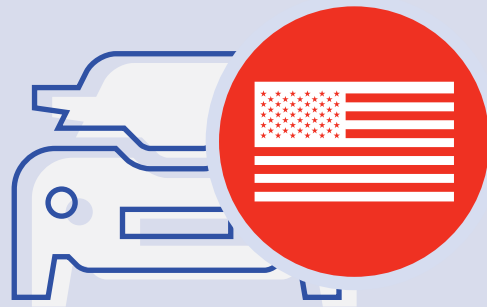

More than half of the parts and components in Canadian-built vehicles originate in the US.



Canada builds 9% of the vehicles Americans purchase annually. US-manufactured vehicles are responsible for over 40% of Canadian vehicle purchases.
